Refunds : Only if you're on the waiting list and we cannot accommodate you on the trip. All others receive a tax deductible donation receipt for the entire fee paid.



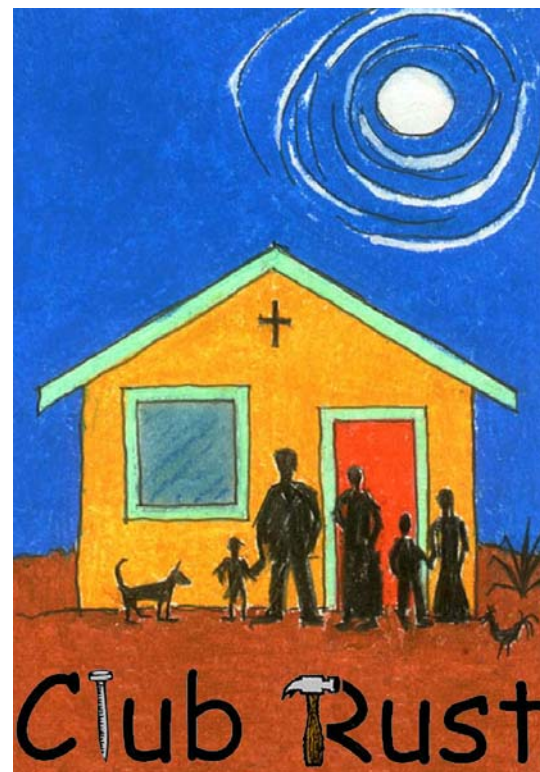

ClubRust is a Christ-centered group of men and women that builds homes for the less fortunate people living in make-shift shelters in Baja, Northern Mexico.



We bless the families in Mexico and demonstrate God's love by providing shelter in the form of a nice solid house. These homes are given to recipient families free of charge.



In tandem with local pastors and Rancho La Paloma Ministry Center, ClubRust is encouraging Betterment and Community Development in the areas that we serve in.

Our trip attracts over 100 people, and is 6 days long. You start by arriving at the airport in San Diego, CA. Our drivers pick you up and whisk you across the border to Rancho La Paloma in Tecate, Mexico.



For the next three days, you will wake up quite early and work with a team of about 20 people building a house and a latrine. Many volunteers have never built a house before, so everyone learns from the more experienced folks.



On day 5 we pack up our gear, visit a local orphanage and the local town, and have a fabulous dinner. The sixth and last day of the trip is spent sharing many wonderful experiences and heading back to the San Diego Airport.



ClubRust is a tangible demonstration of God's message of love and grace for all people. By the end of the trip, the lives of both the family receiving the house and the volunteers building it are touched and forever changed.
